

## About the course

### Advanced Accident (Crash) Investigation (Level II)

This two week Advanced Crash Investigation (Level II) course is an advanced program in the investigation of traffic accidents. It combines both a mixture of classroom and simulated practical experience. It is designed to teach the patrol officer more advanced and technical aspects of accident investigation. The objective of the course is to expand the knowledge and proficiency of the investigator and to provide for a more detailed follow-up investigation on selected traffic accidents. This will not only sharpen skills as an on-scene investigator, but expand ability in courtroom testimony. Each officer must have completed a basic accident investigation (Level I) course prior to enrollment.



### About the Instructors:

**CHRIS WEBER (Reconstructionist)** is a career law enforcement officer with the Eastlake Police Department and is currently serving as a Lieutenant; serving as a shift commander. Lieutenant Weber has served as a patrol officer, field training unit, bomb technician and is currently also serving as an accident reconstructionist with the Lake County Accident Reconstruction unit. He has worked on and assisted in investigating and reconstructing numerous serious injury and fatal crashes throughout Lake County. Lieutenant Weber is also a certified police instructor with the Ohio Peace Officer Training Academy and has taught various basic academy courses and topics at Lakeland Community College. He has also instructed various accident investigation courses for the North Coast Polytechnic Institute in the past.

**Vince Cronin (ACTAR #2389)** was a career law enforcement officer and retired in 2017 from the Eastlake Police Dept. During his law enforcement career, Mr. Cronin was assigned to the Motorcycle Unit, Field Training Unit, and was the Department's Driving Instructor. He also served as the Operations Commander for the Lake Regional Crash Reconstruction Unit and has been involved in countless investigations and reconstructions of serious injury and fatal crashes throughout Lake County, Ohio. Mr. Cronin also served as a basic police instructor with Lakeland Community College and Bryant & Stratton College, as well as the Ohio Peace Officers Training Academy in London, Ohio, instructing courses in Crash Investigation & Crash Reconstruction.

**Matthew Healy (Reconstructionist)** graduated from the IPTM accident reconstruction school and has completed both Basic and Advanced Accident Investigation training through NUTI. Mr. Healy previously worked for 8 years as a professional videographer, specializing in corporate commercials, wedding videography, and training videos. 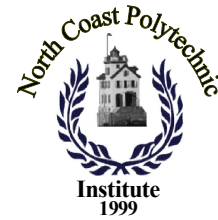
