"CPT: Legal Updates"



In 2011, the OPOTC required that four (4) hours of training be provided to all Ohio peace officers to comply with the mandatory Continuing Professional Training (CPT) requirements under Senate Bill 281. The four (4) hours of training can be in any law enforcement related topic in order to qualify for reimbursement.

This eight (8) hour legal updates seminar will qualify for CPT training hours. The seminar will include a review of search & seizure, laws of arrest and legal aspects of confessions. Case law decisions from the federal and state appellate courts will be provided. In addition, a review of SB 77 will be conducted to include an update on mandatory DNA testing, audio & videotaping of confessions & line-up issues.

About the instructor:



Mr. William D. Healy was a career law enforcement officer for over 29 years. He retired from the Ohio State Highway Patrol after 25 years of service. Mr. Healy was a Staff Lieutenant in charge of the Highway Patrol's Traffic Drug Interdiction Team (TDIT). He also served as a Lieutenant in charge of the Highway Patrol training programs at the Ohio State Highway Patrol Academy. Mr. Healy retired from the State Patrol in January 1999. He has a Bachelor's degree from Ohio University and a Master's degree from Central Michigan University in General Administration. Mr. Healy is a graduate of the Southern Police Institute's Administrative Officers Course at the University of Louisville. He has served as an instructor for the Southern Police Institute (SPI), Northwestern University Traffic Institute (NUTI), the International Association of Chiefs of Police (IACP), the Drug Enforcement Administration and the Drug Interdiction Assistance Program. Mr. Healy currently serves as the Director of Training for the North Coast Polytechnic Institute which is a privately owned criminal justice and law enforcement training company in North Ridgeville, Ohio.
