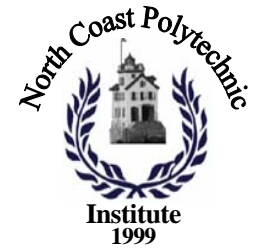

About the course:



“Semi-Automatic Pistol Instructor Certification”

This five (5) day course prepares students to function as semi-automatic pistol instructors. Students will cover the unique aspect of the semi-automatic pistol and semi-automatic pistol shooting techniques. This is not a beginner's course and students should have a working knowledge of the semi-automatic pistol. Topics include: range management, lead and hearing issues, range safety and analysis, and correction of shooter problems. This course meets part of the OPOTC requirements for approval as an in-service Re-qualification and/or Peace Officer Basic Training Firearms Instructor. It does cover criteria needed to be an OPOTA certified semi-automatic pistol instructor.

NOTE: *This course is for new instructors who are not already OPOTA certified as instructors in semi-automatic pistol. Students should have a working knowledge of semi-automatic pistol. This is NOT a beginner's course.*
