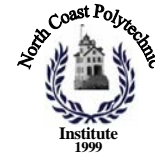

About the course:

"Shotgun Instructor Certification"



This four (4) day course is for students seeking instructional skills with the shotgun. Instruction covers firearms safety, administrative procedure, operational procedure and tactical shooting skills. Students will learn to instruct techniques commonly used in urban and rural environments. They will learn to teach fundamental principles that will increase students speed, accuracy and confidence with the shotgun. Additional topics include: characteristics & accessories, line level maintenance, ready positions, deployment, shooting positions, firing techniques, shooting on the move, barricades, and transition drills.

NOTE: This course is for new instructors who are not already certified as OPOTA instructors in the shotgun. Students should have a working knowledge of the shotgun. This is **not** a beginner's course.

About the instructors:

Mr. Matthew Balli is a career law enforcement officer who has been a member of the law enforcement community for over 18 years. Currently, Mr. Balli is a Lieutenant and assigned as a shift commander for the East Cleveland Police Department. Mr. Balli is a firearms expert who has been certified by the Ohio Peace Officer Training Academy as a trainer-of-trainers in various firearms specialties to include semi-auto pistol, revolver, shotgun, tactical assault rifle, sub-gun and precision (scoped) rifle. He is also an active United States Army Reservist. Mr. Balli has served as an instructor for OPOTA on numerous occasions at their London and Richfield facilities. He has also trained hundreds of law enforcement officers in various firearms courses for NCPI over the past 6 years.

Each student will be required to bring the following with them:

- ⇒ Pump or semi automatic shotgun with a sling
- ⇒ Pistol with 3 magazines
- ⇒ Protective vest & Flashlight
- ⇒ Gym shoes & clothes to move comfortably
- ⇒ 100 slug rounds, 250 buckshot rounds and 250 birdshot rounds
- ⇒ 100 rounds of handgun ammunition
- ⇒ 5 rounds of dummy shotgun ammo
- ⇒ It is strongly recommended to bring Reduced Recoil Shotgun ammunition
