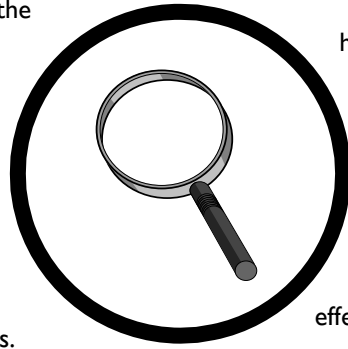

Across this nation, highly trained criminal

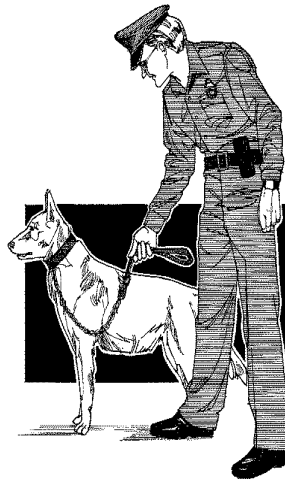


*“Look beyond the traffic stop”...*

## About the instructor:



**Mr. William D. Healy** was a career law enforcement officer for the past 30 years. He retired from the Ohio State Highway Patrol after 24 years of service. He was the coordinator of the Patrol’s Traffic Drug Interdiction Teams (TDIT). Mr. Healy has taught drug interdiction/criminal patrol enforcement throughout Ohio and the United States for the Drug Enforcement Administration, the Narcotics Association of Regional Coordinating Officers (NARCO) and the Drug Interdiction Assistance Program (DIAP). He is also a former adjunct professor of constitutional law at Ohio University. He is the Director of the North Cast Polytechnic Institute (NCPI) in North Ridgeville, Ohio.

**Mr. Terry Helton** is a twenty five (25) year veteran of Ohio State Highway Patrol. For the past twenty (20) years he has been assigned to the Criminal Patrol/Drug Interdiction Unit where he has served as an interdiction trooper, canine handler and supervisor. Currently Terry is a Sergeant assigned to supervisory duties with the Highway Patrol in charge of Criminal Patrol/Drug Interdiction activities throughout Northeast Ohio.
