

Mr. Healy has taught drug interdiction/criminal patrol enforcement throughout Ohio and the United States for the Drug Enforcement Administration, the Narcotics Association of Regional Coordinating Officers (NARCO) and the Drug Interdiction Assistance Program (DIAP). He served as a military police officer in the United States Army for 3 years, having achieved the rank of Sergeant (E-5). He is also a former adjunct professor of constitutional law at Ohio University. He is the Director of the North Cast Polytechnic Institute (NCPI) in North Ridgeville, Ohio.
