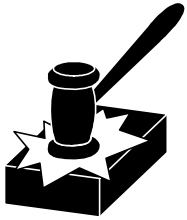


About the course:

“Legal Updates/OVI Laws & SFST Refresher is an eight (8) hour course. Four hours will emphasize recent constitutional case law decisions from the United States Supreme Court, the Ohio Supreme Court, and Ohio Appellate Courts that may affect law enforcement operations to include a review of search and seizure (4th Amendment issues), arrest and confessions and interrogations. A review will also be conducted on OVI Laws and standardized field sobriety tests and the standards relating to strict compliance and substantive compliance.

About the instructor:



Mr. William Healy was a career law enforcement officer for over 29 years. He retired from the Ohio Highway Patrol after serving for 25 years. While on the Patrol, he served for 5 years as a manager/instructor at the Highway Patrol Academy. Mr. Healy has a Bachelor's Degree from Ohio University and a Master's Degree from Central Michigan University in General Administration, and currently serves as the Director of North Coast Polytechnic Institute. Mr. Healy is a graduate of the Southern Police Institute's Administrative Officer's Course at the University of Louisville, and has served as an instructor at the Northwestern University Traffic Institute (NUTI), the International Association of Chiefs of Police (IACP), the Ohio Attorney General's Conference on Law Enforcement, the Drug Enforcement Administration, and the Drug Interdiction Assistance Program. He is a life-time certified instructor with the Ohio Peace Officer's Training Council (OPOTC).
