### "Gang Identification & Affiliation, Safety Issues, School Searches and Identifying, Questioning & Evaluating the Criminal Courier"

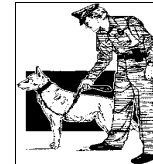


How to identify gang associations, gang graffiti etc. . . .

Finally, a review of how identify, question and evaluate suspects stopped for traffic violations who may be involved in criminal courier activities will be provided.

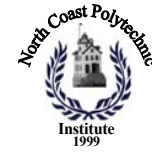
