## Legal Updates – “Confessions & Interrogations (5th/6th Aendment) & Civil Liability



*“Interviewing is an art that must be developed”*

This course is designed to provide information to law enforcement officers concerning updated legal issues. Emphasis will focus upon recent constitutional case law decisions from the United States Supreme Court, Ohio Supreme Court and Ohio Appellate Courts that may affect law enforcement operations to include a review of Confessions and Interrogations and Civil Liability issues. A thorough review of 5<sup>th</sup> Amendment (Right to Silence) and 6<sup>th</sup> Amendment (Right to an Attorney) issues will be provided. In addition, a thorough discussion of civil liability related to patrol car operation, emergency response mode, motor vehicle pursuit, false arrest, illegal search and use of deadly & non-deadly force will be provided. Finally, methods to minimize liability for law enforcement officers will be discussed

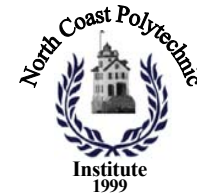
