About the course:

“ Revolver Instructor Certification”



This three (3) day course is designed to cover the revolver. Students taking this course and successfully completing it will have all of the necessary requirements to be certified as a re-qualification instructor for the revolver by the Ohio Peace Officer Training Commission, and a portion of those requirements needed to be certified as a basic training firearms instructor.

The course will be divided into classroom and practical exercises. Curriculum requirements, student performance objectives and instructional techniques will be addressed during the course. A written and practical shooting examination will be administered at the conclusion of the training. Students will be required to pass the state requalification course, with a minimum score of 80 percent in order to continue in the course. This course is for instructors and is not a beginner’s course on the revolver. The training curriculum and instructional objectives for this course are identical to what is provided by the Ohio Peace Officer Training Academy in London, Ohio.

Mr. Vanecek is a career law enforcement officer who has been a member of the law enforcement community for over 20 years. Officer Vanecek is a patrol officer and a self defense tactics and firearms instructor for the Independence Police Department in Independence, Ohio. He is a certified instructor by OPOTA in the Semi-auto Pistol, Revolver, Shotgun and Tactical Assault Rifle/ Carbine Instructor courses and The Firearms Instructor – Weapon Training and Requalification Course. He is a member of the American Society of Law Enforcement Trainers (ASLET) and a member of the International Law Enforcement Educators and Trainers Association (ILEETA).
