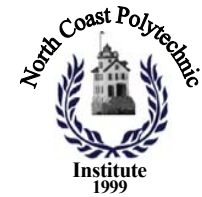

About the course:

“SCRIPT” - Safety in Criminal Patrol and Traffic This two (2) day officer safety and survival school combines substantive lecture presentations with practical red-handled gun traffic stop exercises and scenarios. The seminar will be instructed by street survival experts who taught this class at the Ohio State Highway Patrol Academy.

The school is designed to heighten the awareness of law enforcement professionals to be ever vigilant and alert while performing their traffic stop duties. The instructors combined have over 50 years of law enforcement experience and over 30 years of law enforcement “officer survival” training experience. The course utilizes lecture presentations, videos, slide presentations and practical exercises in red-handled gun traffic stop scenarios to develop an officer survival attitude in each student. Officer safety is everybody’s business; it is a survival “attitude” that must be developed, practiced and rehearsed

About the topics:

- The deadly errors
- Patterns of encounters
- The psyche of survival
- Situational Awareness/Unknown risk contacts
- Contact and cover principles
- Red-handled gun traffic stop exercises and scenarios

NOTE: Each officer must bring their duty holster, duty weapon, body armor, ear protection, and eye protection to the seminar. The red handled guns will be provided by the North Coast Polytechnic Institute; they are completely safe weapons that “cannot” be loaded with any type of “live” ammunition.

About the instructor:



Mr. Toby Smith is a career law enforcement officer who has been employed by the Ohio State Highway Patrol for over fifteen years. Currently, Toby is a Sergeant assigned to the Mansfield Highway Patrol Post as a 1st line supervisor. During his career, Toby had been assigned to the Ohio State Highway Patrol Training Academy for over 4 years where he was a self defense tactics instructor. In addition, Sergeant Smith was in charge of all Highway Patrol officer safety and survival courses. Sergeant Smith has trained thousands of law enforcement officers in street survival techniques.

Mr. William D. Healy was a career law enforcement officer for the past 30 years. He retired from the Ohio State Highway Patrol after 24 years of service. He was the coordinator of the Patrol’s Traffic Drug Interdiction Teams (TDIT). Mr. Healy has taught drug interdiction/criminal patrol enforcement throughout Ohio and the United States for the Drug Enforcement Administration, the Narcotics Association of Regional Coordinating Officers (NARCO) and the Drug Interdiction Assistance Program (DIAP). He is also a former adjunct professor of constitutional law at Ohio University. He is the Director of the Northcoast Polytechnic Institute (NPI) in Lorain County.
