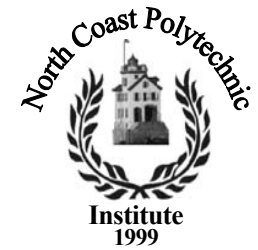

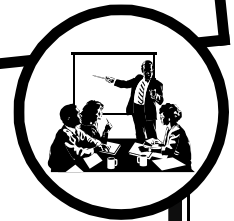

## About the course:



### “Semi-Automatic Pistol Instructor Certification”

This five (5) day course covers criteria needed to be a semi-automatic pistol instructor.

The course also covers areas of range management, lead and hearing issues, range safety, shooter problems and other areas. Also covered in the course is “Shot avoidance for firearms instructors.”

Students taking the course and successfully completing it meet a portion of the requirements for the “Requalification Instructor” and “Basic Peace Officer Firearms Instructor.” Officers assigned as requalification instructors after completing this course have to take the “Firearms Instructor – Weapon Training and Requalification” seminar in addition to this course in order to meet the requirements for requalification instructor.

**NOTE: This course is for new instructors who are not already certified as instructors in semi-automatic pistol. Students should have a working knowledge of semi-automatic pistol. This is NOT a beginner’s course.**
