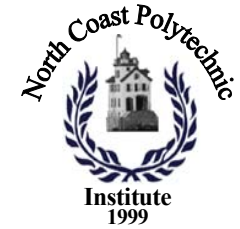

About the course:

“Shotgun Instructor Certification”



This three (3) day course covers criteria needed to be a shotgun instructor. Both pump and semi-automatic shotguns will be addressed. This is a basic instruction and usage course, not an advanced course. Also covered is transition from shotgun to handgun. The course also covers areas of range management, lead and hearing issues, range safety, shooter problems and other areas. Students taking the course and successfully completing it meet a portion of the requirements for “Requalification Instructor” and “Basic Peace Officer Firearms Instructor.” Officers assigned as requalification instructors after completing this course have to take the “Firearms Instructor – Weapon Training and Requalification” seminar in addition to this course in order to meet the requirements for requalification instructor.

NOTE: This course is for new instructors who are not already certified as instructors in the shotgun. Students should have a working knowledge of the shotgun. This is **not** a beginner’s course.

Mr. Balli has served as an instructor for OPOTA in London & Richfield.

Each student will be required to bring the following with them:

- ⇒ Pump or semi automatic shotgun
- ⇒ Protective vest
- ⇒ Flashlight
- ⇒ Gym shoes
- ⇒ Clothes to move comfortably
- ⇒ 200 rounds of 00 buck or 4 buck ammunition
- ⇒ 200 rounds of handgun ammunition
- ⇒ 5 rounds of dummy shotgun
